"To put it in simple terms: knowledge, accountability and stewardship are why it works," said Bill Cooper of Nationwide, who serves as co-chair of the Community Impact Council and has participated as a United Way volunteer for the past four years. "The level of commitment and professionalism of the volunteers has improved consistently over the past four years," Cooper says. "There is an even greater sense of accountability with an orientation toward being true stewards of the donations that are being allocated." Volunteers themselves are usually donors, thus they have a vested interest.

This year approximately 385 total volunteer hours, a conservative estimate, were expended by these volunteers to prepare, review and participate in the community impact process.

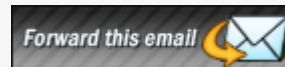
