FY12 Agency Allocations Awarded *Including \$205,000 to support 3 new priority areas*

United Way of Delaware County will invest more than \$2.3 million locally to help fund 24 social service agencies in fiscal year 2012 with the goal of building a stronger Delaware County - one individual and family at a time. And of that amount, \$205,000 will be focused on three community priorities, as identified by the recent Community Needs Assessment process. They are:

- Providing school-based social workers to help at-risk students remove non-academic barriers to learning;
- Offering free healthcare for both unemployed and underemployed individuals without health insurance;
- Conducting financial literacy workshops and incentives to empower people to become financially self-sufficient.
